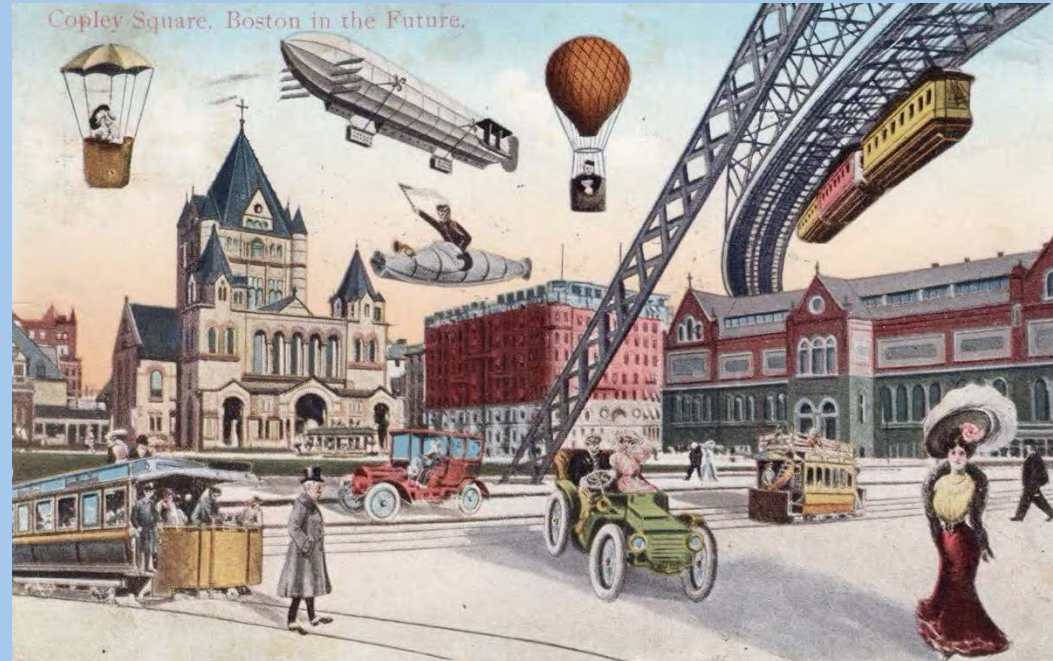
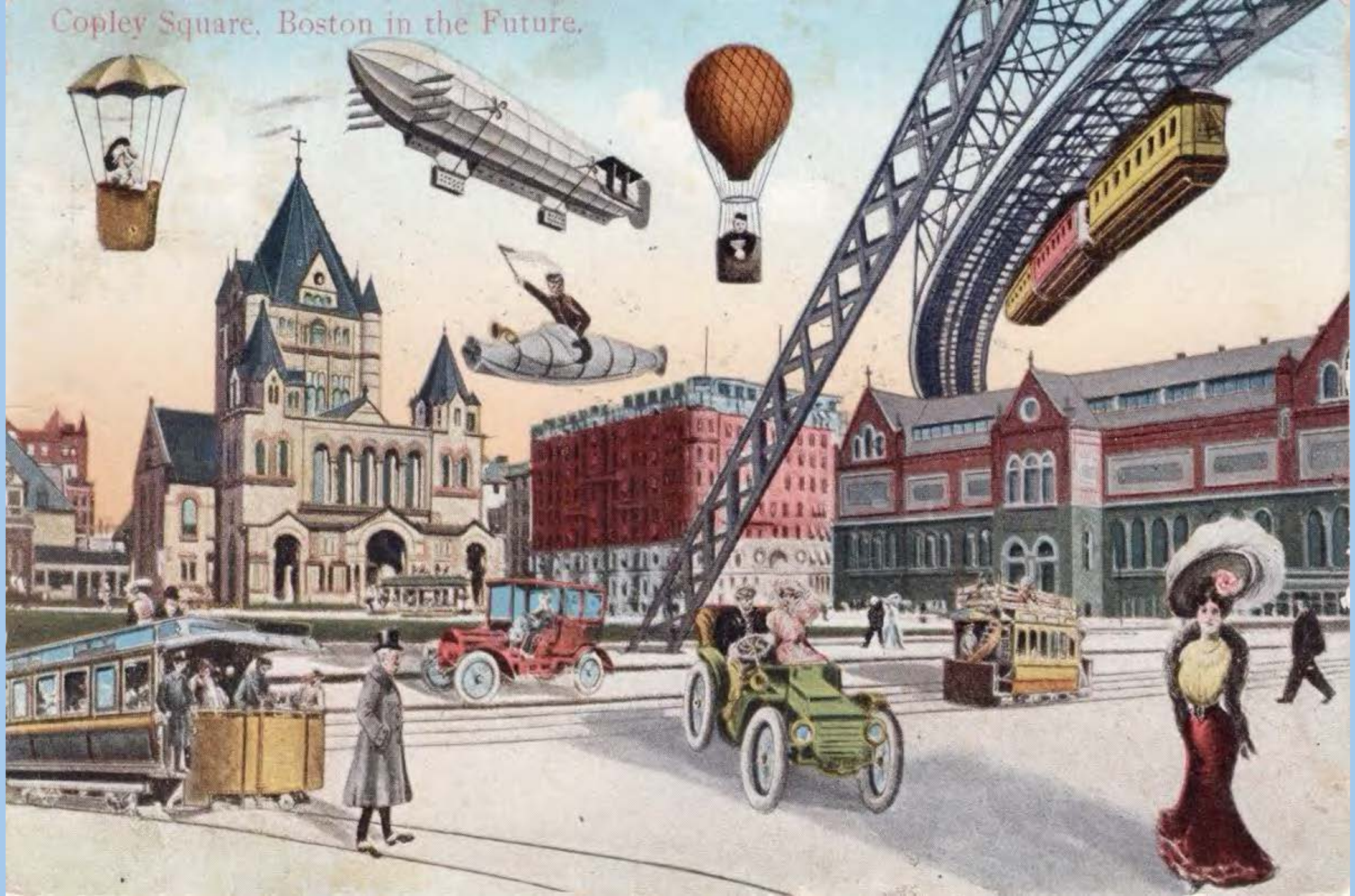

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To the CIRCUIT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES, holden at Boston, within and for the District of Massachusetts:

Respectfully represents William Alpert
residing at No. 12 Willard Street, Boston Mass
in said District, occupation Merchant, an Alien and
a free white person; that he was born in
Russia

on or about
the 22 day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen
hundred and seventy three and is now about thirty two years of
age; that he arrived at Boston in the State of
Mass in the United States of America, on or about the
 day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred
and Eighty nine being then a minor under the age of eighteen years;
that he has resided in the United States three years next preceding his arriving
at the age of twenty-one years; that he has continued to reside therein to the
time of making this application; that he has resided therein five years, including
the three years of his minority; and that for two years next preceding this
application it has been his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the
United States.

And the applicant further represents that he has resided within the United
States for the five years preceding this application, and within the State of
Massachusetts one year preceding the same; that he has never borne any
hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility; that he is
ready to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign
Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever; and particularly to
Edward VII., King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

Nicolas I Czar of Russia
whose subject he has heretofore been; that, during all said residence in the
United States, he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the
principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good
order and happiness of the same; that he does not disbelieve in, nor is he
opposed to, all organized government; that he is not a member of, or affiliated
with, any organization entertaining and teaching such disbelief in, or opposition
to, all organized government; and that he does not advocate or teach the duty,
necessity or propriety of the unlawful assaulting or killing of any officer or
officers, either of specific individuals or of officers generally, of the Government
of the United States or of any other organized government, because of his or

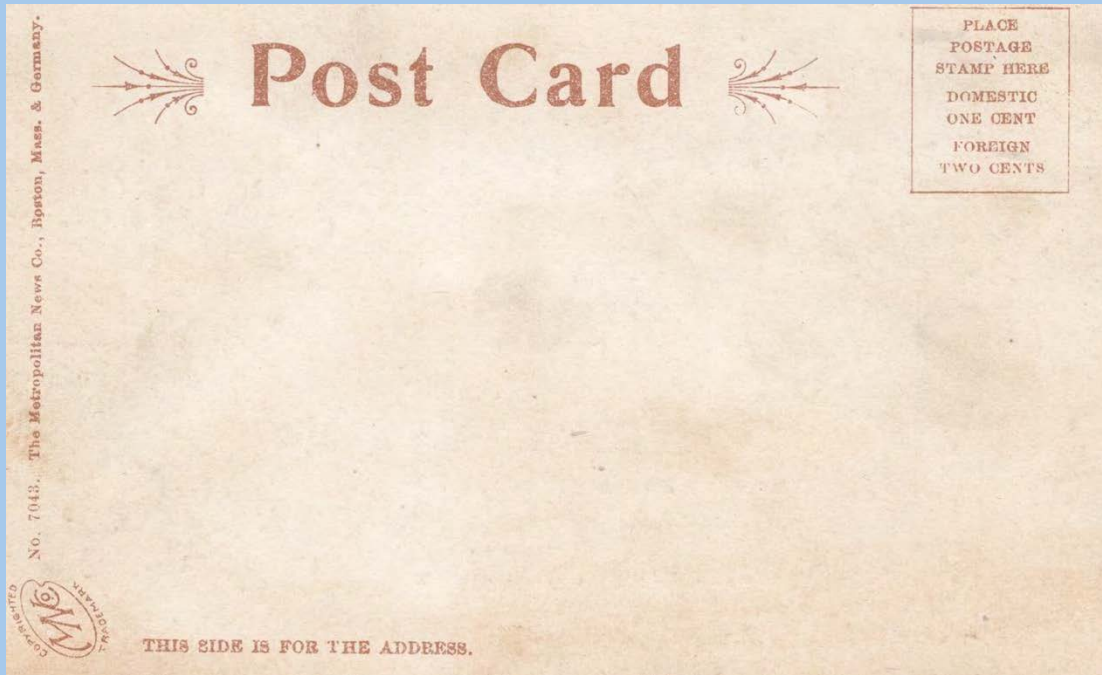

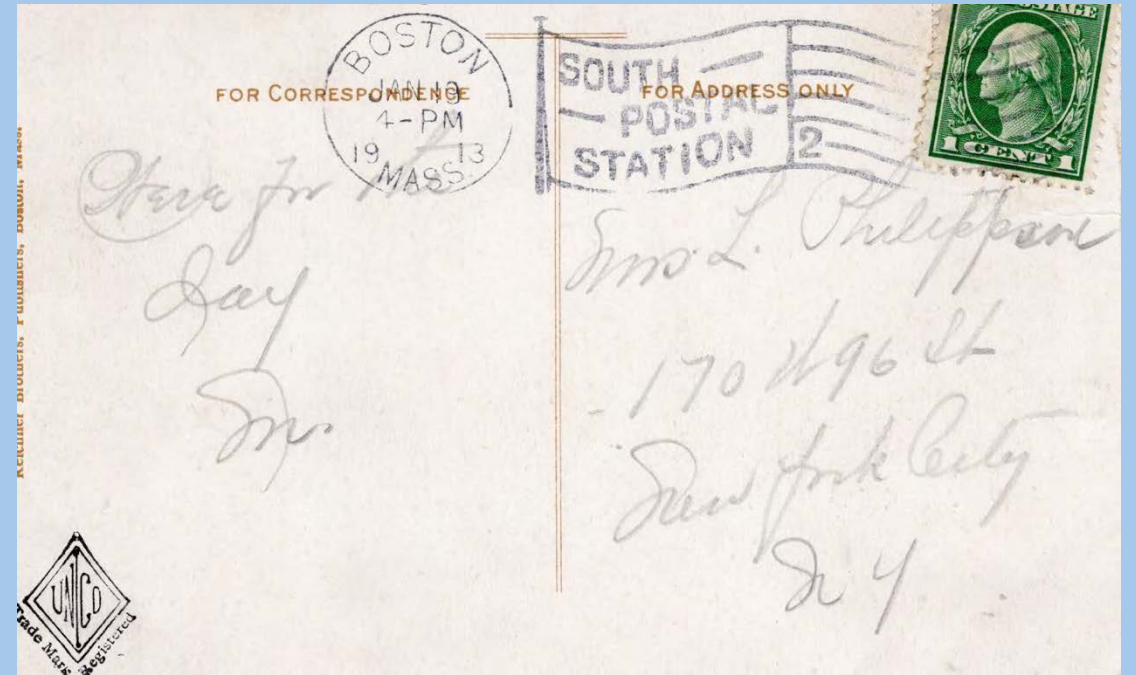

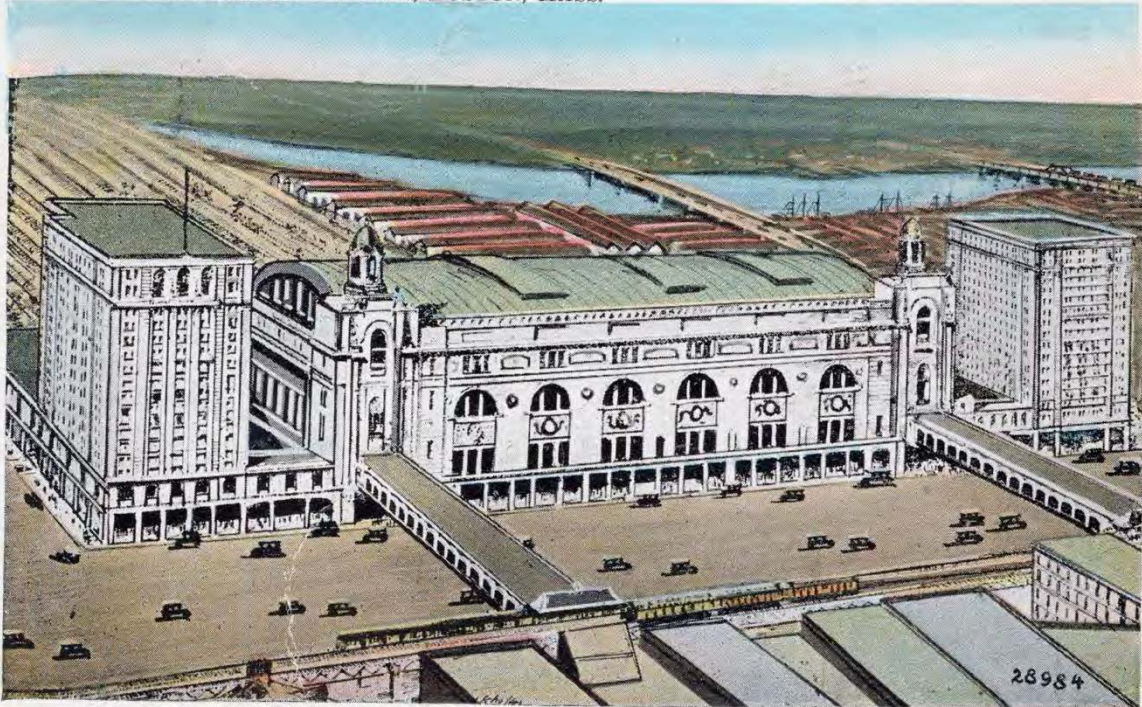


Undivided Era

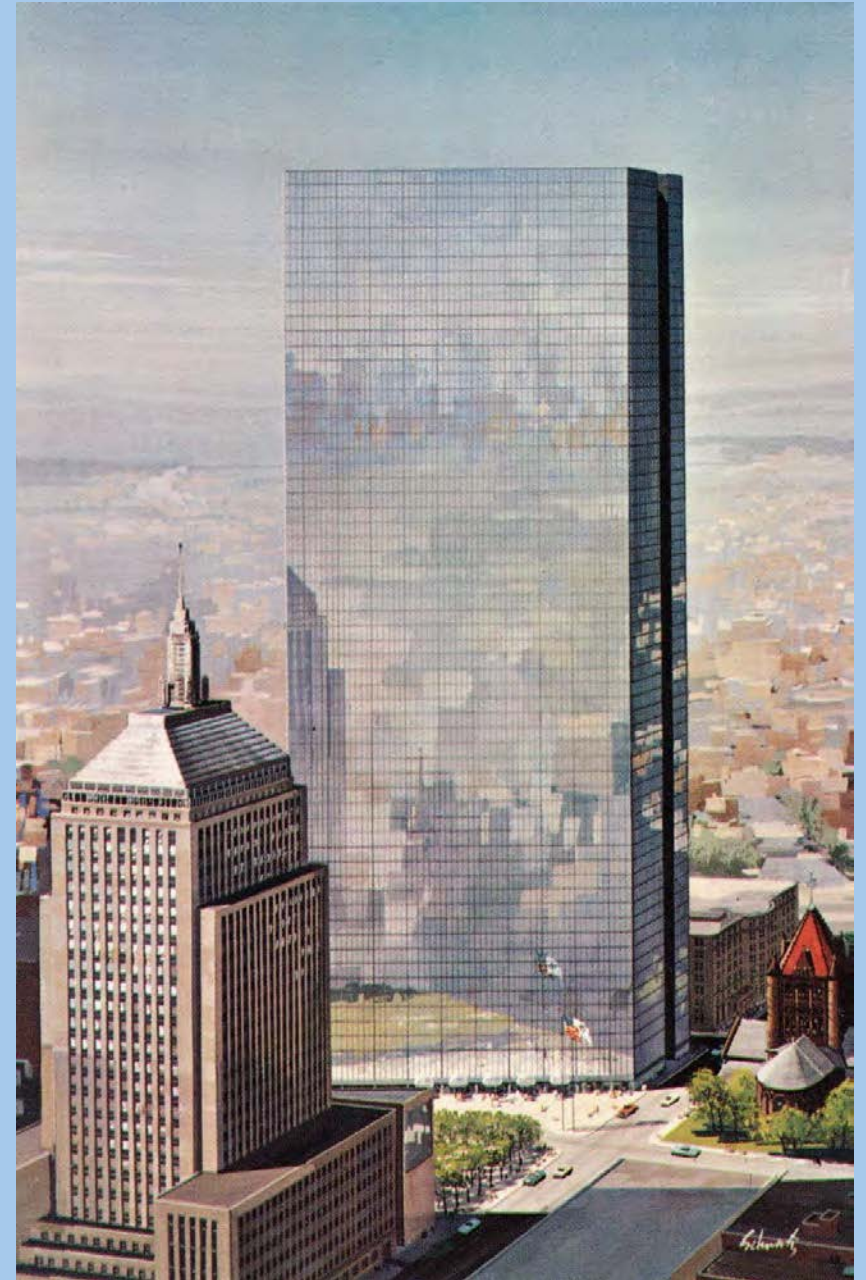

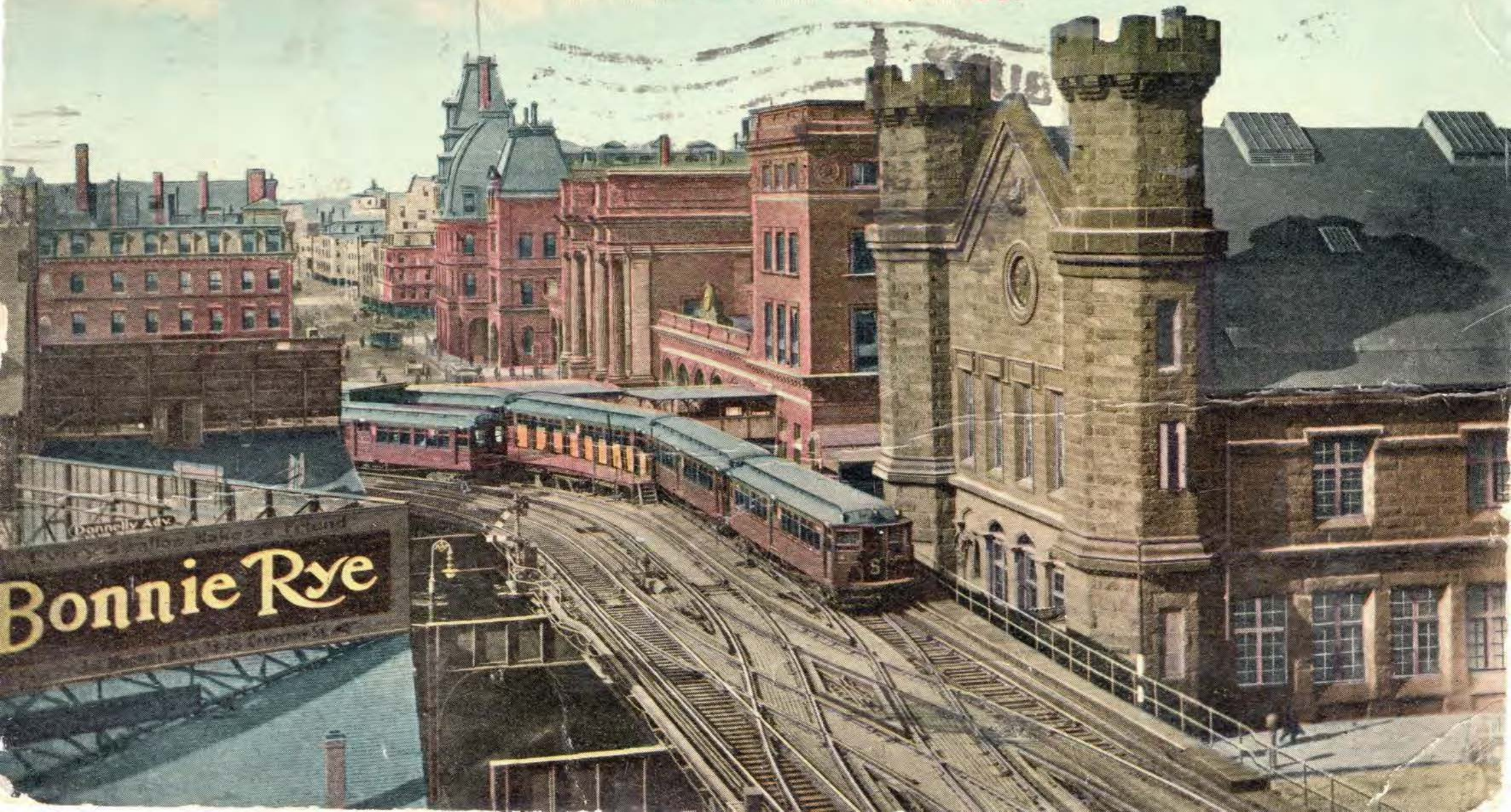

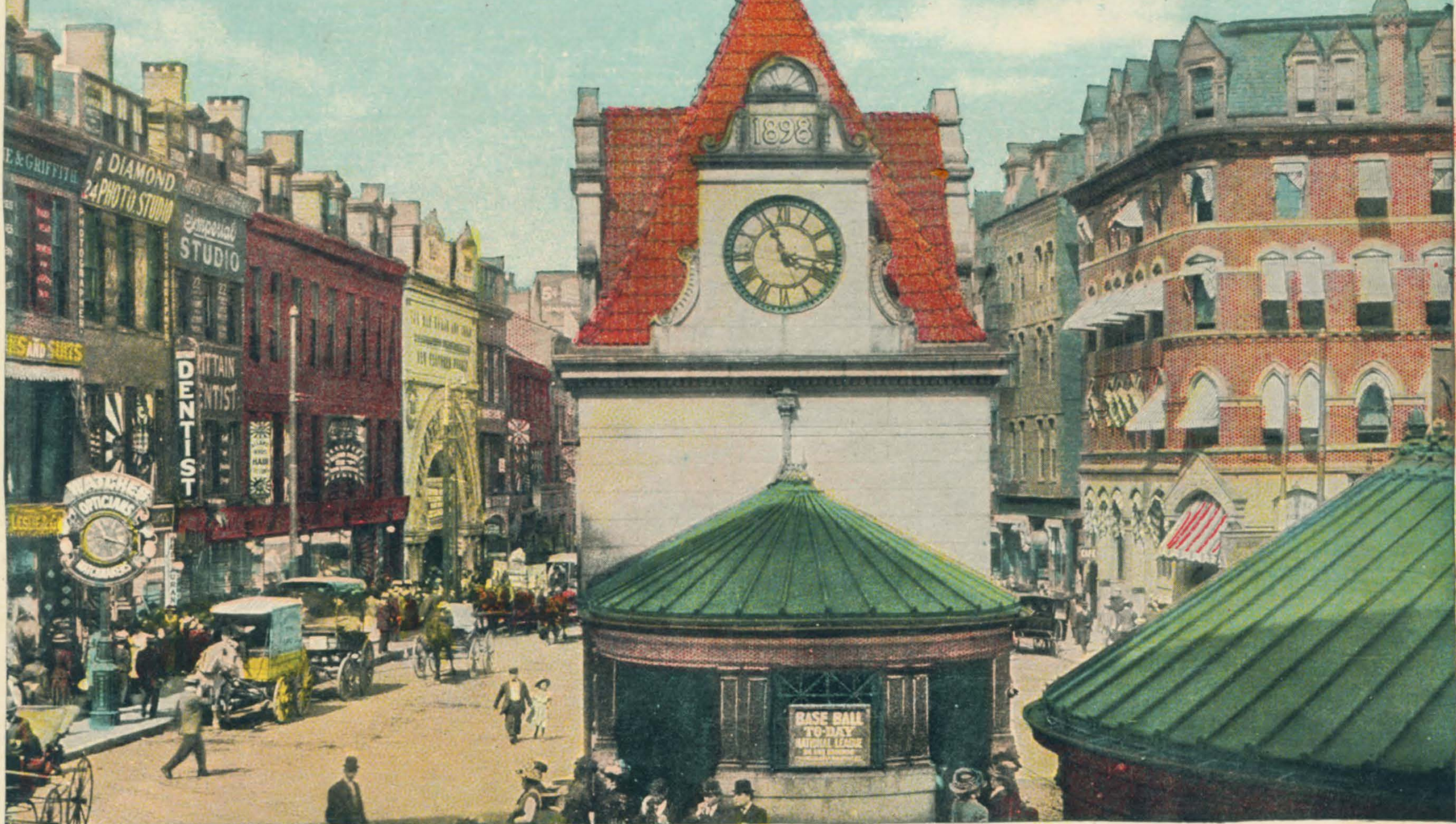

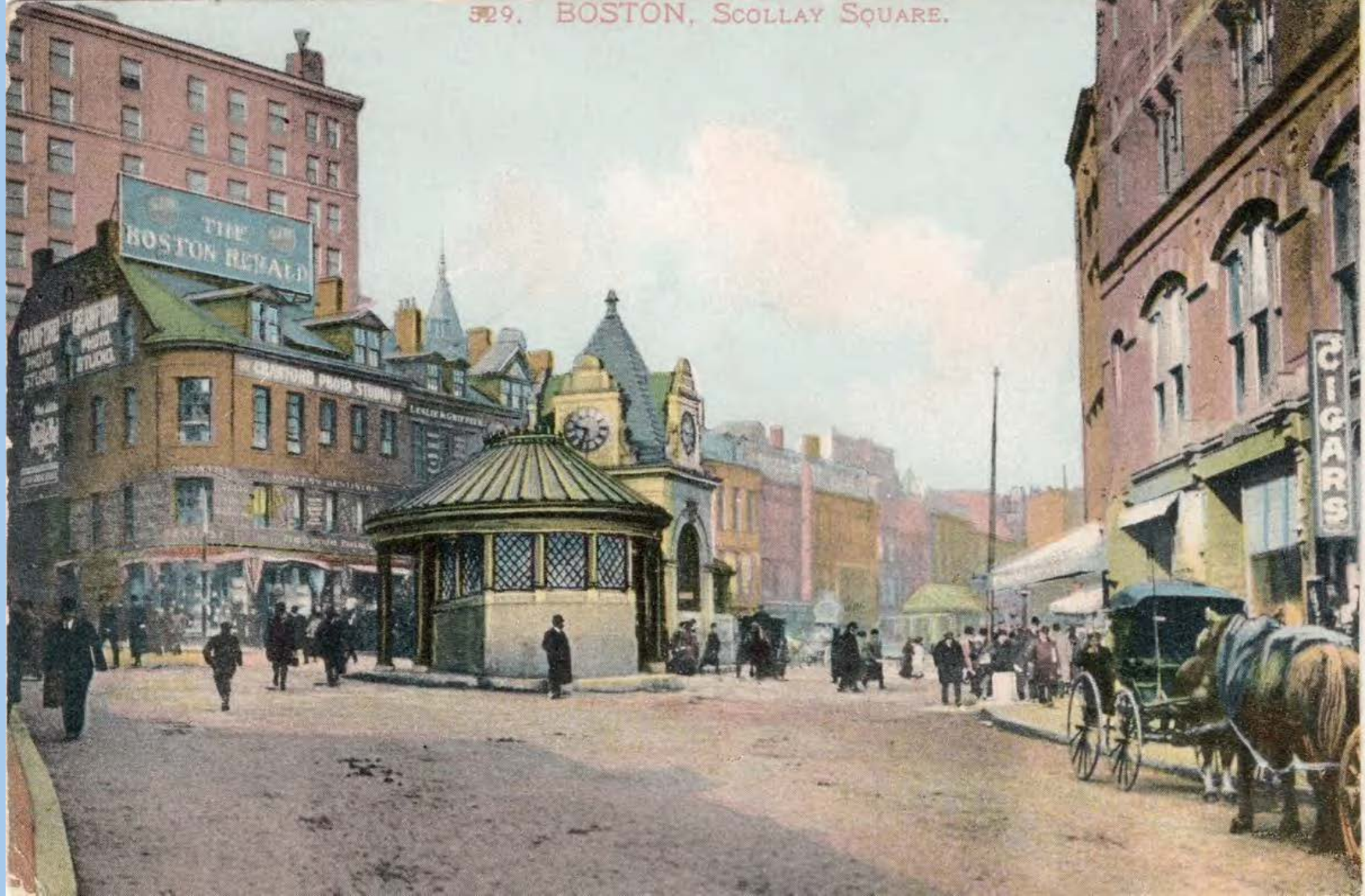

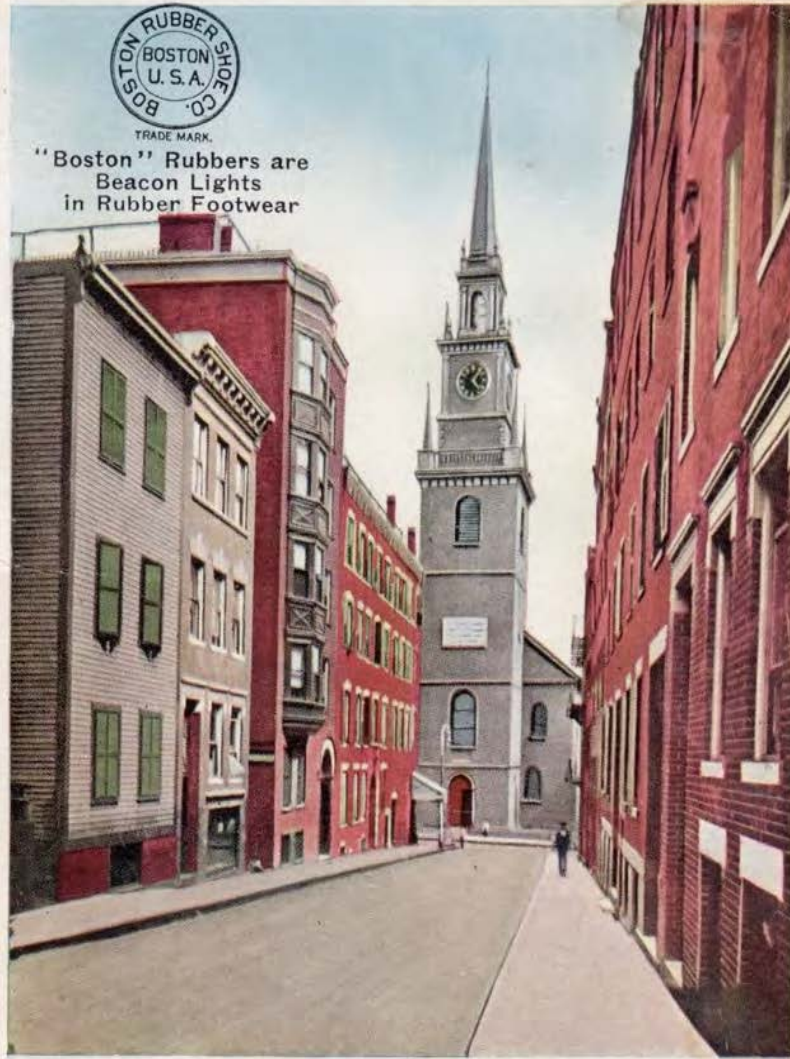

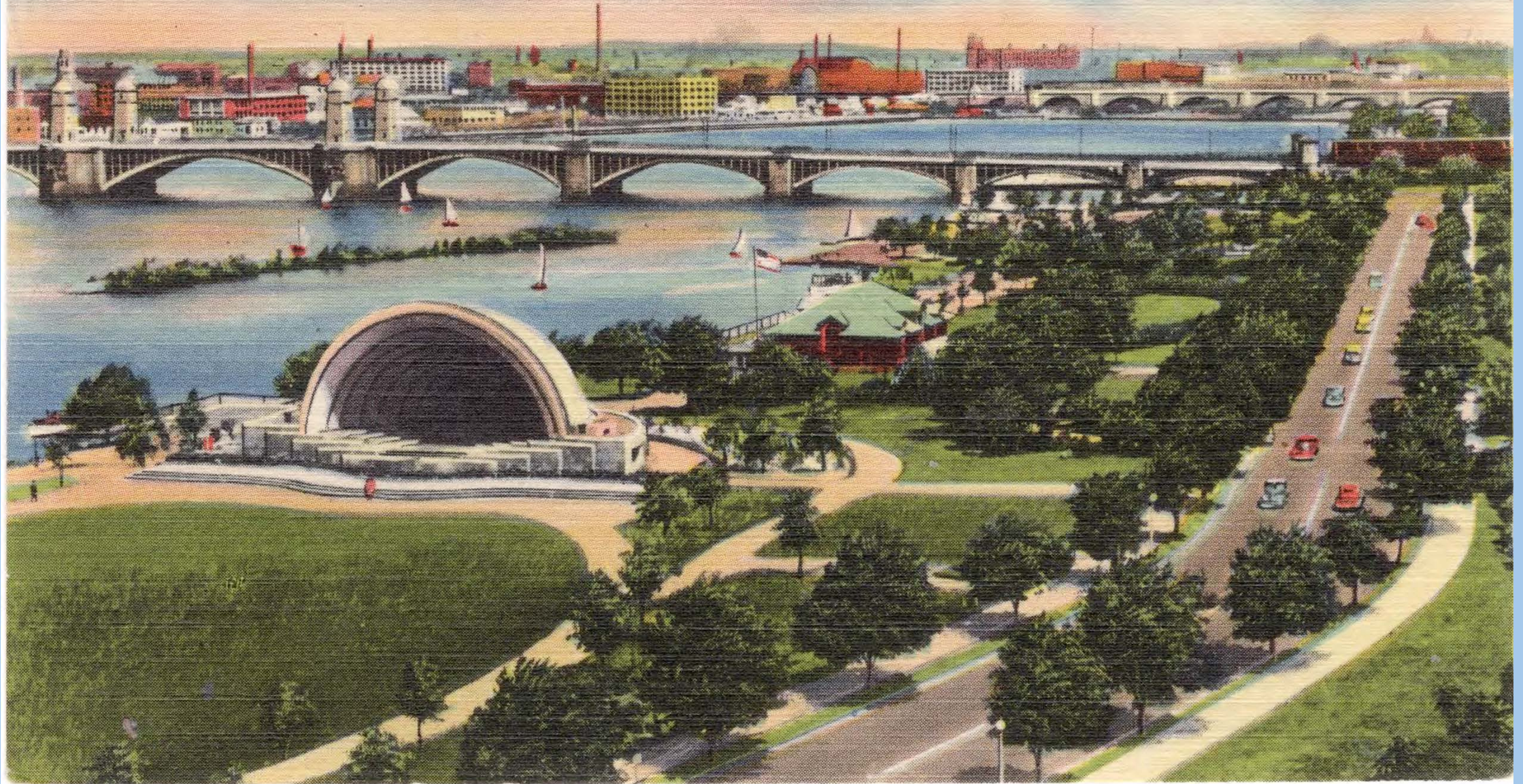

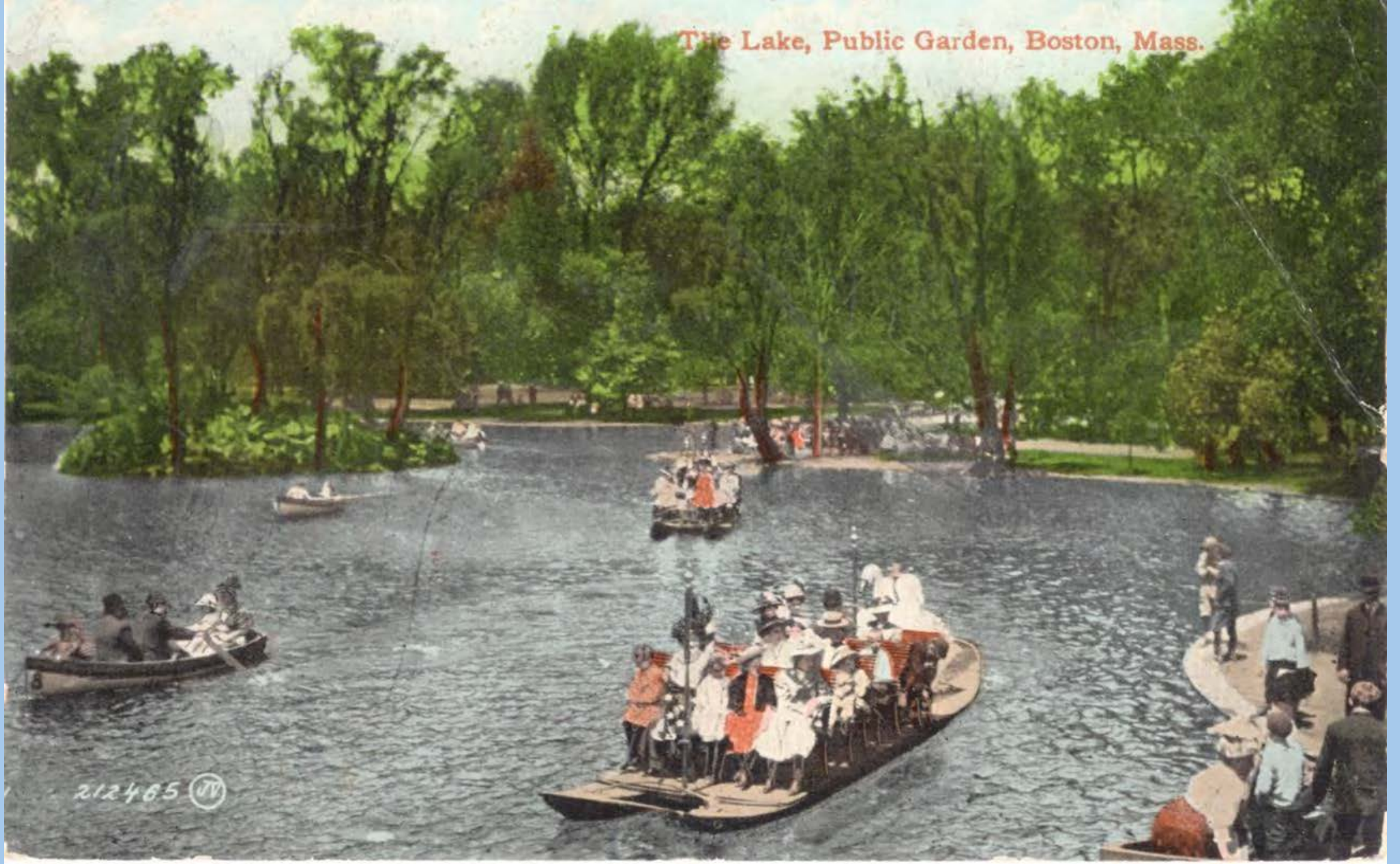

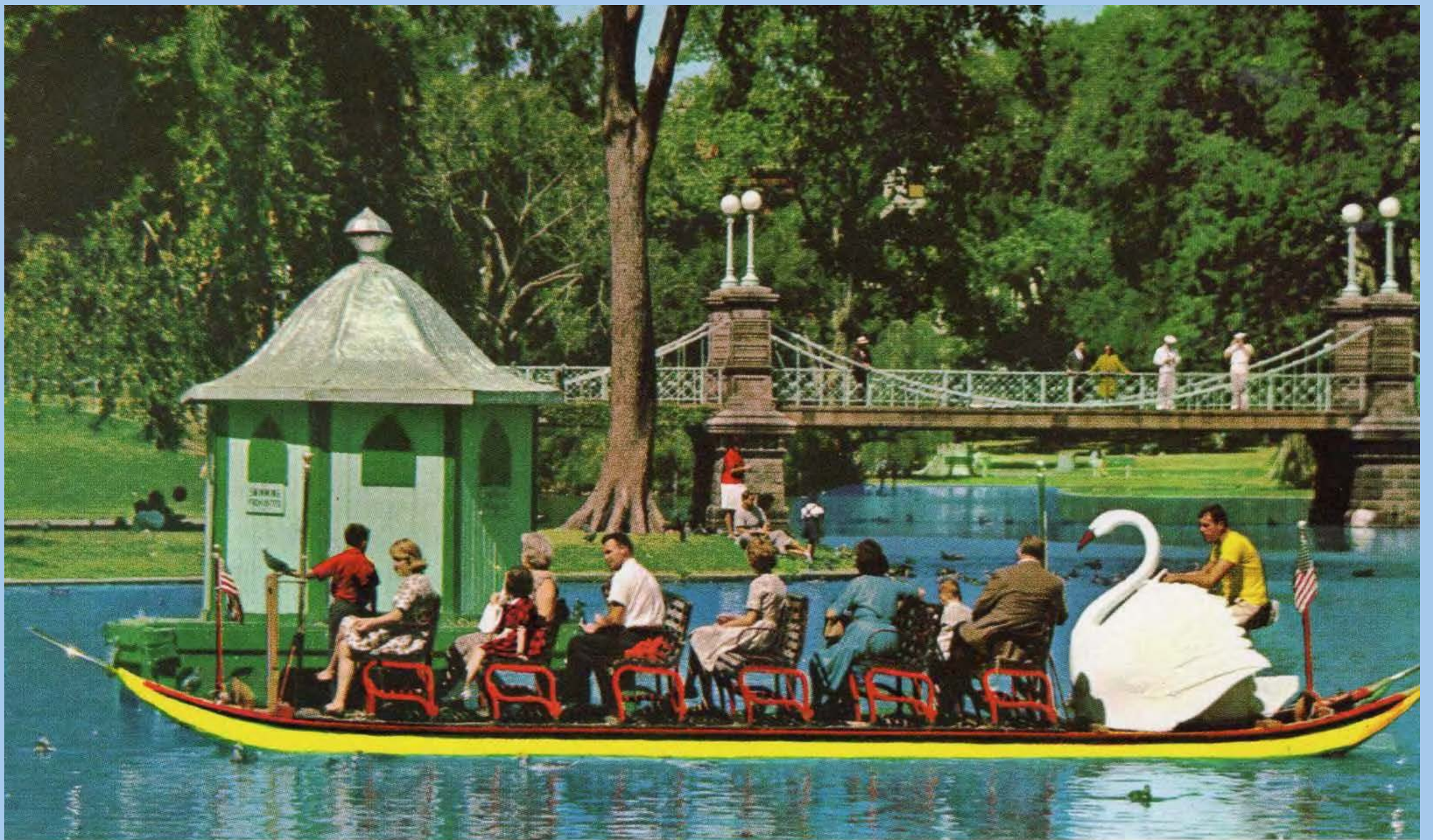
