



UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To the CIRCUIT COURT OF THE UNITED STATES, holden at Boston, within and for the District of Massachusetts:

Respectfully represents William Alpert residing at No. 12 Willard Street, Boston Mass Merchand , an Alien and in said District, occupation a free white person; that he was born in Russia

the ______22 day of August in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and Seventy three and is now about Thirty two years of age; that he arrived at Bosta in the State of

Mass in the United States of America, on or about the day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred

and Eighty wine being then a minor under the age of eighteen years; that he has resided in the United States three years next preceding his arriving at the age of twenty-one years; that he has continued to reside therein to the time of making this application; that he has resided therein five years, including the three years of his minority; and that for two years next preceding this application it has been his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the United States.

And the applicant further represents that he has resided within the United States for the five years preceding this application, and within the State of Massachusetts one year preceding the same; that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility; that he is ready to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever; and particularly to Edward VII., King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,


















Undivided Era 1901-1907

Divided Era 1908 - 1915






White Border Era 1915-1930 Linen Era 1930-1945


